Diputado Francisco Cantu Torres is a native of Monterrey, Nuevo Leon, Mexico. He is currently serving in the 71st Nuevo Leon State Legislature. He is a dentist by profession specializing in Orthodontics. He has had managed his dental office since 1983 in Monterrey.

He has served as President of the National Action Party in Monterrey 1993-1996; Councilman of the City of Monterrey 1994-1997; State Legislator of Nuevo Leon 1997-2000; Member of the Federal Chamber of Deputies and serving as Chair of the Social Development Committee 2000-2003; Candidate for Mayor of the City of Monterrey 2003; and Federal Delegate in the State of Nuevo Leon to the Ministry of Social Development.

He graduated as a dentist from the National Autonomous University of Nuevo Leon in Monterrey in 1979 and completed a post-graduate studies in Orthodontics at the Argentinean Orthodontic Association in Buenos Aires, Argentina from 1981-1983. He also completed certificated courses in Public Administration at the Northeast Mexican University of Monterrey from 1995-96.

He is a professor of Embryology and invited professor for the Faculty of Orthodontics at the Nuevo Leon Autonomous University in Monterrey.

He is married to Maria de Rosario Gonzalez and has six children.
